PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Candy, gum, snacks, knives, weapons of any kind, fireworks, radios, TV’s, electronic games, cell phones, or animals. LUGGAGE: Children will need to carry all their belongings from the bus to the cabins (about 300 yards away). Please limit luggage to just one suitcase, backpack, or duffle bag, plus one sleeping bag or bed roll. Don’t bring unnecessary items. Make sure all items are marked.

WHAT TO WEAR:

- **Old clothes** for outdoor use that you are not concerned about getting heavily soiled!
- **Sturdy shoes** for outdoor use that you are not concerned about getting dirty or wet!
- Winter jacket, gloves, and winter hat (only for December-February fieldtrips)
- Hat
- Sunglasses (Optional)

WHAT TO BRING:

- **Reusable water bottle**
- Mud Boots or tall rain boots (optional, but helpful if taking Wetlands Class)
- Raincoat and cap (a poncho is good)
- Insect repellent and sunscreen

PLEASE DO NOT BRING: Candy, gum, snacks, knives, weapons of any kind, fireworks, radios, TV's, electronic games, cell phones, or animals. Please don't bring nice clothing/shoes—only old clothes should be brought, as new clothes will be ruined by heavy outdoor use!
